Part 1: Mission Statement

Mission: COCC at DRCI provides a positive learning environment for Adults in Custody to achieve student success and promote a productive reentry into the community.

Part 2: Strategic Plan Connection

Access: COCC's Education Department provides access to Adult Basic Education, Career and Technical Education, and College Classes to incarcerated adults at Deer Ridge Correctional Institution.

Workforce Development: COCC's Education Department at DRCI provides training in the field of welding to 12 students per year to complete the Welding One-Year Certificate of Completion. The welding department at DRCI partners with Oregon Employers, Iron Workers 29, and WorkSource Oregon to assist the students in finding employment when released.

Part 3: Goals and Activities

Goal 1: ABE students will work to improve their Math and Reading skills.

Goal 2: GED students will work towards passing the GED Mathematical Reasoning, Language Arts, Social Studies, and Science tests.

Activities

- ABS team will participate in the Oregon Adult Basic Skills Conference and professional development opportunities provided by the ODOC Education and Training Unit.
- ABS team will use the skills learned in their training to train the AIC tutors that work one-on-one with the students.

Measurement Tool and Timeline

Goal/Outcome 1:

- Outcome: 42% of ABE students will achieve at least one Measurable Skill Gain on the CASAS assessment each year.
- Measurement: ODOC Education and Training Unit will send a quarterly Contracted Performance Summary report. Students' success will meet or exceed the goal each year.

Goal/Outcome 2:

- Outcome: 42% of GED students will complete the GED per year.
- Measurement: ODOC Education and Training Unit will send a quarterly Contracted Performance Summery report. Students' success will meet or succeed the goal each year.
