BASIS OF SELECTION:

The scholarship may be given to any resident of Crooked River Ranch who is a current college student or an adult continuing their education. The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of merit and motivation and shall be for the immediate upcoming academic year. There will be no deferrals. The selection will be made by the Crooked River Ranch Lions Scholarship Committee.

This is a one-time award. You may re-apply for the scholarship another year, but the award will only be granted a maximum of two times.

Only completed applications, including all signatures requested, attachments such as transcripts and two letters of recommendation received in a single packet by the Crooked River Ranch Lions Scholarship Committee at their post office box (below), postmarked no later than **April 1st** of the scholarship year will be considered. If the deadline falls on a weekend, the following Monday will be used as the deadline date. The Crooked River Ranch Lions will not acknowledge receipt of applications. If verification of receipt is desired, send the application via Certified US Mail or any carrier that has tracking ability. Faxes are not accepted. Late applications will not be considered.
