



In recognition of the service and sacrificed of military service personnel, COCC is honored to offer a tuition waiver to children and spouses of permanently disabled or fallen service members.

Additional eligibility requirements:

- Student must be considered an Oregon resident at the time of application for the waiver.
- A spouse must initiate the waiver request within ten years of the determination of death or 100% disability. The spouse will lose eligibility upon remarriage.
- Waiver applies to students age 23 and under.
 - ⇒ Students age 24 years or older must have initiated waiver by age 23 and maintain continuous enrollment (with the exception of summer term) toward the degree/program they were most recently working toward.
 - ⇒ Students may appeal for an exception due to extenuating circumstances.
- Waiver applies to a credit level certificate or degree program. The maximum waiver granted is the total number of credit hours that equals two years of full-time attendance, or an Associate's degree, whichever comes first.
- Student must meet COCC's academic and financial aid satisfactory academic progress requirements.

Student must submit waiver for academic year in which you wish to receive waived tuition by the tuition due date to avoid late fees.

⇒ The tuition waiver can be applied retroactively only for current academic year.

- For "last-dollar" waivers, students must submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and complete the requirements necessary to determine aid eligibility.
- This form will show as a requirement in financial aid. It will **not** stop financial aid from processing.

Please choose waiver type below that describes your situation:

- "First-Dollar" Waiver - COCC will provide a "first-dollar in" tuition waiver to the spouse and children age 23 and under (including adoptive and step-children) of members of all branches of the United States Armed Forces or United States Coast Guard who: a) died while on active duty; or b) died as a result of a military service-connected 100% disability.
- "Last-Dollar" Waiver - COCC will provide a "last-dollar in" tuition waiver to the spouse and children age 23 and under (including adoptive and step-children) of members of all branches of the United States Armed Forces or United States Coast Guard who: a) is 100% permanently disabled as a result of a military service-connected disability as certified by the U.S. Department of Veterans' Affairs; or b) died as a result of less than a 100% disability as connected to military service; or c) meet criteria "a" or "b" above, but also received the Marine Gunnery Sergeant John D. Fry Scholarship.
